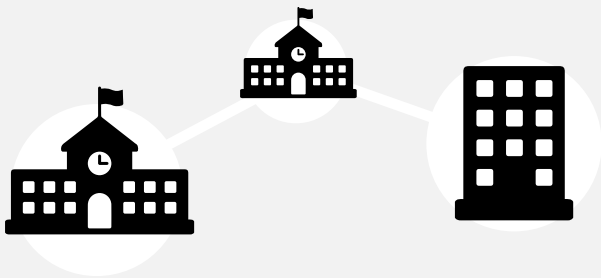


## 3 Steps to Jump-Start Your Active Threat Planning Project

### STEP 1 Identify Your Buildings/Areas

Identify which buildings or event areas may need active threat plans.

- Consider needs for after-school events including stadiums, parking lots, and other open-air spaces
- Assess if you also need interior School Safety Maps (annotated floor plans, a.k.a. “Critical Incident Mapping”)



### STEP 2 Identify Your Stakeholders

Successful ATP often starts with simple collaboration between planners and responders across agencies and organizations.
